Minimum requirements for the proposed item:

- Electric drive with an approximately 3-6 horsepower capacity.
- 48 volt electrical system
- Charger, matched to the vehicle by the manufacturer.
- Approximate width 60 inches
- Approximately 16 cubic foot cargo box with power dump
- Two-person seating capacity
- Delivery to the James Farm Ecological Preserve, 30048 Cedar Neck Road, Ocean View, Delaware

Quotations shall include a detailed description of standard and optional features on the quoted item. Product literature should be sent via PDF format. Please consider the environment if sending traditional printed literature. Quotations must be submitted by 5:00 PM EDT on March 31, 2023.

Please indicate anticipated delivery date.

The James Farm Ecological Preserve is owned by Sussex County, Delaware. It is located at 30048 Cedar Neck Road (Tax Map 1-34-9 Parcel 93.01). It is operated by the Center by virtue of an occupancy agreement approved by County Council September 17, 2017 and signed September 26, 2017. The quoted item will be specified, purchased, maintained and insured by the Center for use at the Preserve. It will be property of the Center.
